

Battle of the Sexes

Competition Format

- Players enter as "MIXED PAIRS" (although individuals may enter and the organisers will try to match them up.) The Organisers will run a computerised draw that randomly moves players away from their normal partners into groups of 4: 2 men & 2 ladies.
- The idea is to draw two girls against two boys, for the Battle of the Sexes. Once the groups have been made up the names will be entered onto the Timesheet on the computer. **This to be set as Read Only so alterations can only be made by the Match Committee or the Pro Shop.**
- COMPETITION, All players will complete individual stableford cards. These results will be sent to Golfink for handicapping. The Battle of the Sexes competition will be as follows:
 - Lady A v Man A based on overall stableford score. Winner: 1 point
 - Lady B v Man B based on overall stableford score Winner: 1 point
- There will be individual prizes for ladies and men
- At the end of the day the points for all groups will be totalled, and all members of the winning team (Men or Ladies) will receive a ball each.
- There will also be a prize for the best "MIXED PAIR" couple (you will be linked back to your partner from the registration form. All couples will have their joint total stableford points entered for this prize).
- DINNER. Tables of 8. Players to sit with the group they played with.
- Ladies Captain and Men's Captain to be appointed
- Men to wear **BLUE**. Ladies to wear **Pink**
- Each individual to indicate on the entry form if they require a cart.
- As couples are separated in the draw, couples who have their own cart, should allocate their cart to one person. Each individual to indicate on the entry form if they HAVE a cart (yes) or NEED a cart (NEED).
