TERMS OF COMPETITION

All players must be a current financial member of the VWGA of NSW Inc. or affiliated associations and hold a current GA Handicap.

Registration will be vi Mi- Tournament from the 8th of January Golflink number must be included when registering

Golf Carts will be allowed weather permitting, carts are also to be booked vi Mi Tournament on registration.

Payment must accompany registration.

Players must report to the starter 30 minutes prior to hit off time and must be on their designated tee ready to play at least 10 minutes before the allotted start time.

The Ladies Match Committee reserves the right to alter or vary the programme if deemed necessary.

The format of the starting procedure is a shotgun start off all 18 tees. Start time will be 8.30 am but it will only vary depending on weather and entries.

Maximum daily playing handicap is 45.

Divisions and handicap limits for each division will be determined after close of entries.

No refunds will be given after completion registration has been closed.

Draw will be published on Nelson Bay Golf Club Website from Thursday 24th April 2025.

The MiScore scoring app is available at Nelson Bay Golf Club on mobile device and is our preferred way of scoring.

The phone function of a mobile phone must be turned off or in silent mode and only used in an emergency.

The rules of Golf and Local Rules of Nelson Bay Golf Club will govern play.

Disputes and /or protest will be resolved by the Match Committee and their decision will be final.

Players play at their own risk.

In the event of a tie, results will be decided using the GA Countback system. The last 9 holes on the card will be used, regardless of the order of play.

Tournament is under the control of the Nelson Bay Layes Golfing members under the auspices of the VWGA OF NSW Inc.

No player may win more than one trophy per day, excluding Nearest the Pin, Accurate Drive, etc.

Play ready golf in a safe and responsible way.

Play at a prompt pace through out the round.
