2026 LADIES GALA DAY – CONDITIONS OF PLAY

To be read in conjunction with the current GNSW Standard Conditions of Play.

1. The competition will be a four person DROP OFF AMBROSE team event. A maximum daily handicap of 45 per player will be applied to any player with a handicap over 45. Scoring on the MiScore app is preferred. If using a card, it is the responsibility of the team to process their card through the card machines located in the Clubhouse lounge area upstairs, directly after play has finished.
2. The field will be limited to 160 players on a first received basis.
3. The event will be a shotgun start to run over 3 courses with tees to be allocated by a draw. The draw will be available on the website 5 days prior to the event.
NB: late changes may be necessary.
4. Entries will close one week prior to the event unless maximum numbers reached. No refunds will be given after the closing date except at the discretion of the Match Committee.
5. The rules of golf and the local rules of NBGC shall be the rules of play during the competition.
6. Motorised transport is permitted. The Nelson Bay Ladies committee does not take any responsibility for the availability of carts on the course. This is the responsibility of the individual players to book their cart through MiTournament when registering for the competition.
7. All ties to be decided by the Australia Countback Method.
8. Three (3) Nett and one (1) Scratch prize will be awarded per course, but a team cannot win both scratch and Nett prizes.
9. Handicaps will be as of Wednesday night prior to the competition.
10. The decision of the Nelson Bay Ladies Golf Club Match Committee will be final.
11. There will be one (1) closest to the line (CTL) per course and one (1) nearest the pin (NTP) for each course to be shared with the team.
